## Let's go to Jogashima.

Jogashima is located on the southernmost tip of the Miura Peninsula, and on sunny days, in addition to enjoying stunning sunrises and sunsets, Mt. Fuji can also be seen. This is a two-star view in the Michelin Green Guide Japan.



### Umanose-domon

Umanose-domon is a natural art, with an eyeglass-a hole opened in the rock due to erosion from the waves, rain and wind. It is magnificent and mysterious to look through this rock out to the Pacific Ocean.



### Jogashima Park

On a sunny day, the expansive panorama of the ocean spreads out from the observation point. It is also a popular site for flower viewing, with daffodils and hydrangea etc.

For Jogashima, get off the Keihin Kyuko Bus "Hakushuhimae" stop from Misakiguchi Station



### Cormorant Observation Point

A view that shows the majesty of nature. From late October through April you can see flocks of Cormorant, which are indicative of winter in Jogashima.

### Kawazu cherry blossoms

The "Miura Kaigan Sakura Festival" is held from February 5 to the 1st Sunday in March every year. About 1,000 sakura trees can be enjoyed along the track from Miura Kaigan Station.

### Koajiro-no-mori

This is a sight unique to the Kanto region which consists of a basin which flows into the sea from tidelands formed by wetlands as rain develops into a river. This 70 hectares of natural heritage is home to about 2,000 types of organisms.

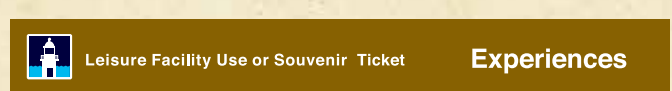

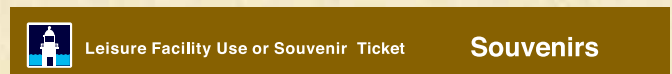

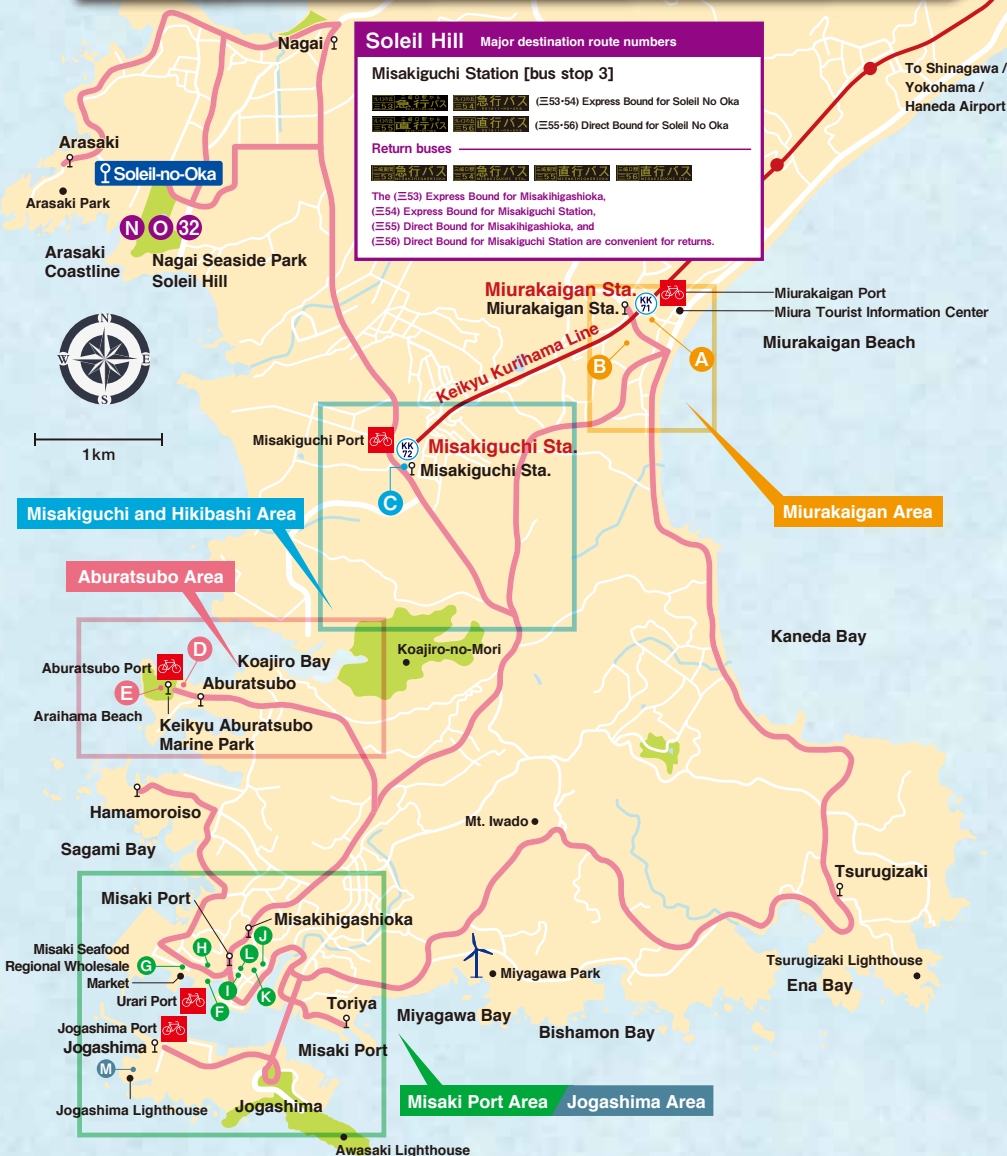
