Yokosuka tourist spots



Verny Park

This park incorporates a French garden style and was created in honor of the French engineer Leonce Verny who worked on many of Yokosuka's outstanding buildings. Visitors to the park can see battleships up close.

5 minutes' walk from Shioiri Station



Dobuita Street

This is a bar street where at night the marines who work at the Yokosuka Base gather, lending the area a mix of Japanese and American culture, and making it fun just to walk around.

Sarushima

The only uninhabited island in the Tokyo Bay, rising out of the ocean off the coast of Yokosuka. The island has a mysterious air with tunnels and magnificent brick walls. Visitors to the island can feel adventurous while exploring the military fort, take a swim, or enjoy themselves in a variety of ways.

15 minutes' by ferry from Mikasa Wharf after taking a train to Yokosuka-chuo Station and walking 15 minutes' or taking a Keihin Kyuko Bus to the "Mikasa Wharf" bus stop.

The birthplace of "Sukajan"

These jackets originally became popular as souvenirs for the American soldiers stationed in Yokosuka. The designs feature tigers and dragons, which the American soldiers viewed as iconically Japanese. The jackets have also become popular in Japan, and are called "Sukajan", an abbreviation of the Japanese pronunciation of "Yokosuka Jumper", because they originated in Yokosuka.

The Leisure Facility Use or Souvenir Ticket (C) can also be used to rent jackets. (November to March only. See P10)



Hashirimizu Jinja Shrine

This shrine is known as a symbol of marriage bonds and a place for increasing one's femininity, making it a much visited place by many women in Japan.

Kannonzaki Lighthouse



Kannonzaki Park

This park features lush natural greenery as well as coastal lines, military ruins, the Shizen Hakubutsukan, the Kannonzaki Lighthouse, which is Japan's first western-style lighthouse, and much more.

Kannonzaki Park (Kannonzaki Lighthouse): Keihin Kyuko Bus from Maborikaigan Station or Uraga Station to the "Kannonzaki" bus stop (then a 14 minutes' walk to the lighthouse). Open all day (Lighthouse is open from 9:00 to 16:00)/Closed December 29 to January 3/Free

Yokosuka Navy Burger

The establishment of a US military base also brought a variety of American culture to Yokosuka, leading to the area becoming one of the places where the hamburger was introduced to Japan. In 2008, as a sign of friendship from U.S. Navy Yokosuka Base, the classic U.S. navy hamburger recipe was gifted to Yokosuka City. This is a simple burger that uses no filler in a 100% red meat beef patty with onions and tomato on top. The burger is also known for its large size. The "Yokosuka Navy Burger" then began being offered by restaurants in the city based on this recipe. Each restaurant adds their own style and touches while still preserving the original recipe's methods.

Yokosuka Kaigun Curry

In the Meiji Era, a Japanese naval doctor became interested in the curry stew that was eaten by British sailors. The dish was adopted for meals in the Japanese navy thanks to its good nutritional balance and easy preparation. Soon flour was added to thicken the stew, and it was served over rice, leading to birth of "curry rice". The dish then spread from Yokosuka, which was a major base for the navy, to the rest of Japan. And now, curry rice has become one of the most loved dishes in Japan. Yokosuka Kaigun Curry is a recreation of the original recipe. Each restaurant adds their own touches to the basis roux, making for many popular and unique curries.

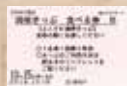
Yokosuka's fresh ingredients

Yokosuka City is surrounded by the ocean on three sides, and a rich variety of seafood is caught at the city's fishing ports. Yokosuka is also home to a rich agriculture industry. The city's weather is warm and temperate, and cabbage, tomatoes, zucchini, pumpkin and a wide variety of other vegetables as well as watermelon, strawberries and other fruits and crops are harvested in the hilly, sea breeze swept fields. Direct sales shops and morning markets where customers can purchase these local ingredients draw many visitors, even from other prefectures. In addition, the city also features many popular restaurants and cafes where customers can enjoy various dishes using these fresh ingredients.

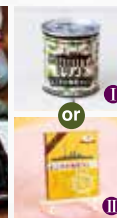

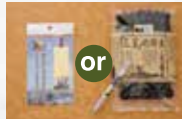
