Launch of the "YOKOHAMA BAY AREA 1 DAY PASS'

IC Rail Pass Cards Targeting Visitors from Overseas









Keikyu Railway will launch an IC rail pass card targeting visitors from overseas called the "YOKOHAMA BAY AREA 1 DAY PASS" on Sunday, September 1, 2019.

Three types of YOKOHAMA BAY AREA 1 DAY PASS will be available, each offering visitors a day of unlimited travel on Keikyu and Minatomirai Line trains within the validity area in the Yokohama Minatomirai district, which has many attractive sightseeing opportunities. Pass holders can also enjoy special benefits at participating shops and facilities in the district by presenting the reference papers issued upon purchase of their passes.

To purchase a YOKOHAMA BAY AREA 1 DAY PASS, you will need the "PASMO PASSPORT," a

special IC card for overseas visitors, which will also launch on Sunday, September 1, 2019. The PASMO PASSPORT can be repeatedly charged with cash and used to ride trains and buses and pay for goods and services where IC card payments are accepted. Please see the attachment for further details.

Only valid on the day of purchase

- 4. Details
- (1) Haneda-Yokohama Pass
 - Free travel on Keikyu Line trains from Keikyu Line Haneda Airport Domestic Terminal Station to Yokohama Station
 - Free train travel on the entire Minatomirai Line

Example user: A visitor from overseas who arrives at Haneda Airport, wants to go sightseeing in the Yokohama Minatomirai district all day, and will stay at a hotel in the district.

(2) Haneda-Tokyo-Yokohama Pass

- Free travel on Keikyu Line trains from Keikyu Line Haneda Airport Domestic Terminal Station to Keikyu Kamata Station, and from Keikyu Line Sengakuji Station to Yokohama Station
- Free train travel on the entire Minatomirai Line

Example user: A visitor from overseas who arrives at Haneda Airport, wants to go sightseeing in the Yokohama Minatomirai district all day, and will stay at a hotel in Tokyo.

(3) Tokyo-Yokohama Pass

- Free travel on Keikyu Line trains from Keikyu Line Sengakuji Station to Yokohama Station
- Free train travel on the entire Minatomirai Line

Example user: A visitor from overseas who is staying at a hotel in Tokyo and wants to go sightseeing in the Yokohama Minatomirai district all day.
